Please note that all **programming** information for TVEC3 and TVEC4 are the same for both Concert Strings Legacy and Concert Strings 2. So, for example, if you purchased Concert Strings Legacy and see documentation that seems to be for Concert Strings 2, this is because the information in those particular documents refer to both Concert Strings 2 AND Concert Strings Legacy.

Also note that there may be places that state that the samples are not related to Diamond, Emerald or Ruby. Concert Strings Legacy is indeed created from the best of the Diamond Symphony Library.

The Sordini (muted) Strings in Concert Strings Legacy is INCLUDED in the Diamond Symphony Library, but NOT in Concert Strings 2.
